

GREENHAND CHAPTER CONDUCTING PROBLEMS Area FFA Leadership Development Events #3 2023



I.

- 2. There is much debate on the pending motion.
- 3. The previous question receives the necessary vote.

II.

- 2. A member moves to award a scholarship to the Outstanding Senior FFA Member.
- 3. A second rank amendment proposes an amount of \$1,000.
- 4. The motion to award a \$500 scholarship to the Outstanding Senior FFA Member is tabled.

III.

- 1. The sentinel informs the president that he/she is wanted in the counselor's office.
- 2. The motion to charge \$10 to attend the FFA banquet is seconded by the reporter.
- 3. Following much opposition, the reporter moves to refer the motion to a committee.
- 4. The main motion is withdrawn by general consent.

IV.

- 1. The president returns and states that a donor will sponsor a \$500 scholarship. The president then decides to award a \$500 scholarship to the Outstanding FFA Officer.
- 2. Following an appeal, the chair is not sustained.
- 3. The question in Problem II is brought back before the chapter for further consideration.
- 4. The chapter votes to award a \$500 scholarship to the Outstanding Senior FFA Member.
