I.

1. Present the motion to conduct an aluminum recycling project.
2. A second rank amendment fails to receive a majority vote.
3. A motion to refer fails to receive a majority vote.
4. The motion passes to conduct an aluminum and cardboard recycling project, and the president informs the chapter of her/his decision that the dates shall be December 4-15.

II.

1. The motion to purchase a cell phone for the advisor is heavily debated.
2. A motion to have a counted standing vote is passed.
3. The vote on the main motion results in a tie.
4. A member rises to a point of order since the president did not vote to break the tie.

III.

1. The sentinel informs the president that he/she is wanted in the superintendent's office.
2. The secretary moves to have a scholarship application workshop for FFA seniors.
3. Following some discussion, the motion to postpone until the next regular meeting is offered.
4. The motion to postpone until the next regular meeting requires a more accurate vote.

IV.

2. A member appeals the president's decision for the chapter's aluminum and cardboard recycling project to be December 4-15.
3. Properly dispose of the appeal.
4. A motion to cancel the action taken in Problem I is debated, then failed.
