I.

- 1. Present the motion to conduct an aluminum recycling project.
- 2. A second rank amendment fails to receive a majority vote.
- 3. A motion to refer fails to receive a majority vote.
- 4. The motion passes to conduct an aluminum and cardboard recycling project, and the president informs the chapter of her/his decision that the dates shall be December 4-15.

II.

- 1. The motion to purchase a cell phone for the advisor is heavily debated.
- 2. A motion to have a counted standing vote is passed.
- 3. The vote on the main motion results in a tie.
- 4. A member rises to a point of order since the president did not vote to break the tie.

III.

- 1. The sentinel informs the president that he/she is wanted in the superintendent's office.
- 2. The secretary moves to a have a scholarship application workshop for FFA seniors.
- 3. Following some discussion, the motion to postpone until the next regular meeting is offered.
